General Regulations:

Juna Cup 2026 will include the following disciplines:

- Single Ladies and Men (Class YA, I, II, III, IV, V)
 - Free Skating (Bronze, Silver, Gold, Masters)
 - Artistic Free Skating (Bronze, Silver, Gold, Masters)
- Solo Ice Dance
 - Pattern Dance (Bronze, Silver, Gold, Masters)
 - Free Dance (Bronze, Silver, Gold, Masters)
- Pairs Skating
 - Free Skating (Adult, Intermediate, Masters)
 - Artistic Free Skating (Adult, Intermediate, Masters)
- Ice Dance
 - Pattern Dance (Bronze, Silver, Gold)
 - Rhythm Dance (Bronze, Silver, Gold)
 - Free Dance (Bronze, Silver, Gold)

Age categories for ladies and men free skating and artistic free skating events:

Young adults (YA) skaters born between	July 1st, 1997 and December 31th, 2004
Class I skaters born between	1st July 1987 and 30th June 1997
Class II skaters born between	1st July 1977 and 30th June 1987
Class III skaters born between	1st July 1967 and 30th June 1977
Class IV skaters born between	1st July 1957 and 30th June 1967
Class V skaters born on or before	30th June 1957

For Pairs Free Skating and Ice Dancing events both partners must have reached the age of 18 by July 1st, preceding the event and must not have reached the age of 71 by July 1st, preceding the event.

The Organizers have the right to combine categories if the number of participants requires. The judging will be done in new system (according to ISU regulations). Technical rules for adult figure skating competitions will be used.

Registration of entries:

All ISU-Members and all Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category and class. However, the Organizer

shall have the right to limit the number of skaters from the invited clubs, and split categories if the number of participants requires that.

By registering for the Juna Cup 2026 competition, the club confirms that it has the consent of adult athletes for the performance, audio and video recording of the performance, and publication of the athlete's performance.

The club is responsible that each athlete participating in the competition has legal music used during the performance.

The deadline for entries is **15. December 2025**. All entries to the Juna Cup 2026 must be submitted using the **Sportity Online Registration system**: <https://fs.sportity.com/> . The clubs, that don't have an account should contact Sportity by email: info@sportity.com and inquire about registration by providing the following information: Name of Organization, Reg.code, Country, contact e-mail address.

Music and Planned Program Content must be submitted together with registration!

Entry fees:

First Single event —90€ per person

Second Single event —40€ per person

First Solo event —90€ per person

Pattern Dance (2 dances) Solo event —110€ per person

Second Solo event —40€ per person

Third Solo event - 30€ per person

First Pair/Ice Dance event —100€ per pair

Second Pair/Ice Dance event — 60€ per pair

Practice 25 min —20€ per person or 40 € per pair

Entries made after **15.12.2025** and before **29.12.2025** will be charged extra 10€ per person or 20€ per pair. The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reasons.

Payment must be made by money order right after registration during 5 days but not later than **29.12.2025**

Competition schedule:

A detailed time schedule will be available 7 days before the competition at the competition website.

Final timetable shall be announced at the opening draw.

Draw:

An electronical draw will take place on January 14-th, 2026, starting orders will be published on our website: www.juna.ee

Practice:

Practice (25 min) will take place at Haabersti ice rink. Practice fee is 20 € per person/per practice or 40 € per pair/per practice and **should be paid with entry fee**. Practice groups will be made by skater's level. Practice registration will be opened 2 weeks before competition. There is no guarantee join practice without registration.

Expenses:

The organizer does not pay any expenses of the teams. Travel expenses, and accommodation will be covered by the participants.

Expenses related to the competition's technical management will be covered on account of the entry fees and sponsorship by the Organizer.

Protocol:

Protocol will be available at the Skating Club Juna website. The Organizers shall not provide print-outs or CD-s.
