#### **General Regulations:**

The Juna Cup Kids 2026 competition will be held for young and beginner skaters single skaters, solo ice dance and ice dance. The Juna Cup Kids 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 and all respective ISU Communications for figure skating and the technical requirements of the Estonian Skating Union for the season 2025/2026. The results will be calculated according to ISU judges system.

Participation in the Juna Cup Kids 2026 is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

The Organizers have the right to split and combine categories if the number of participants requires that.

### **Registration of entries for Juna Cup Kids 2026**

All ISU-Members and all Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category and class. However, the Organizer shall have the right to limit the number of skaters from the invited clubs, and split categories if the number of participants requires that.

By registering for the Juna Cup Kids 2026 competition, the club confirms that it has the consent of the parents of minor athletes and the consent of adult athletes for the performance, audio and video recording of the performance, and publication of the athlete's performance.

The club is responsible that each athlete participating in the competition has legal music used during the performance.

The deadline for entries is **15. December 2025**. All entries to the Juna Cup 2026 must be submitted using the **Sportity Online Registration system**: <https://fs.sportity.com/> . The clubs, that don't have an account should contact Sportity be email: [info@sportity.com](mailto:info@sportity.com) and inquire about registration by providing the following information: Name of Organization, Reg,code, Country, contact e-mail address.

**Music and Planned Program Content must be submitted together with registration!**

Each Competitor must have its own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of MP3 file.

Entry fee\*:

Single skaters with one program —85€ per person

Single skaters with two programs — 100€ per person

Solo Ice Dance skaters — 110€ per person  
Ice Dance Couple — 140€ per couple  
Elements — 60€ per person

Entries made after **15.12.2025** and before **29.12.2025** will be charged extra 10€ per person or 20€ per pair. The entry fee is a registration prerequisite, failure to pay the entry fee by the deadline can result in a rejected or disqualified entry. Payment must be made by money order right after registration during 5 days but not later than **29.12.2025**

\* Entry fee includes an entrance fee 5 euros per person and their accompanying persons.

Payment can be made 100% to a bank account . Club can change one skater to another in the same category 24 hours before the drawing. The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries. Payment must be made to:

According to the ISU Rule 119, the Organizer accepts no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for property lost or damage incurred by any Competitors or any kind of Officials.

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU com. 2641. Action against this rule conducts behind itself the disqualification of skater.

**Protests:**

Each team has the right to submit protest against the judge's decision. Protests must be submitted to the Referee of the relevant event at the latest immediately after the event. Upon the submission of the protest a protest fee of 50 EUR must be paid. The referee's decision is final. In the new ISU Judging Systems no protests can be filed against the judges (see Rule 123), but against the right determination of the executed element or any calculation error. In the ISU Judging System protest can be submitted in 24 hours after subsegment (e.g. Short Program) and before the awarding ceremony after the final segment (e.g. Free Skating). Protest must be done in a written form to the referee of the relevant segment. Please read ISU Rule 123.
