General Regulations:

The Juna Skate Open 9th competition will be held for young and beginner skaters. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 and all respective ISU Communications for figure skating and the technical requirements of the Estonian Skating Union for the season 2024/2025.

Participation in the Juna Skate Open is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and its member Clubs, and qualify for eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a). They meet the participation requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication. All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation or its Member Clubs.

The results will be calculated according to ISU judges system.

Registration of entries for Juna Skate Open 9th

All ISU-Members and all Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category and class. However, the Organizer shall have the right to limit the number of skaters from the invited clubs, and split categories if the number of participants requires that.

The deadline for entries is <u>24. March 2025</u>. Entries must be submitted in a online written form to <u>jelena@juna.ee</u> Please provide your contact information (e-mail, phone) on the

entry form. In case of late entry for competition, plus 10 EUR will be added to the entry fee.

Entry fee:

Single/Solo skaters with one program —85€ per person
Single/Solo skaters with two programs — 100€ per person
Ice dance/Pair with one program — 120€ per couple
Ice dance/Pair with two programs — 140€ per couple (two patterns/rhythm+free skating)
Elements - 60€ per person

Deadline for payment is 1. April 2025.

Payment can be made 100% to a bank account or 50% to a bank account + 50% in cash on accreditation (NB! in this case club has to pay for all competitors who are in the starting order list after the draw). Club can change one skater to another in the same category 24 hours before the drawing. The entire club will not take part in draw in case of not paid 50% of entry fees before 1. April 2025. Any changes in entry form has to be made at least 24 hours before drawing. The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries. Payment must be made to:

Draw:

Mandate:

All participating clubs are asked to send their final entry forms for the draw by **April 22 th 2025**, 12 p.m.

Planned Program Content:

Competitors are asked to send their planned elements by **April 18th 2025** at the latest. The Sheet must be filled according to the ISU element abbreviations.

Music:

All Competitors shall furnish in advance competition music of excellent quality via e-mail to <u>jelena@juna.ee</u> until <u>Aprill 22nd, 2025</u>, in accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2. Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s).

The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient. Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.

Liability:

According to the ISU Rule 119, the Organizer accepts no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for property lost or damage incurred by any Competitors or any kind of Officials.

The code of ethics:

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU com. 2342. Action against this rule conducts behind itself the disqualification of skater.

Protests:

Each team has the right to submit protest against the judge's decision. Protests must be submitted to the Referee of the relevant event at the latest immediately after the event. Upon the submission of the protest a protest fee of 50 EUR must be paid. The referee's decision is final. In the new ISU Judging Systems no protests can be filed against the judges (see Rule 123), but against the right determination of the executed element or any calculation error. In the ISU Judging System protest can be summited in 24 hours after subsegment (e.g. Short Program) and before the awarding ceremony after the final segment (e.g. Free Skating). Protest must be done in a written form to the referee of the relevant segment. Please read ISU Rule 123.
