## 1. General

The Mozart Cup is an Interclub Competition. It will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations and in accordance with the rules of the Austrian Figure Skating Association.

Men 4 min. + / - 10 sec

**Senior:** Ladies and Men born after 01 July 1994  
Short Program: 2 min. 50 sec. max.  
Free-Program: Ladies  
4 min. + / - 10 sec

### 3. Ice Dancing

Free Dance: 4 min +/- 10 sec.

Acc. to ISU Rule 610, and ISU - Communication No. 1449, 1462, 1496, 1522

### 4. Entries:

All clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with the I.S.U., are invited to take part in the competition.

Each club may enter xx competitors in each category.

In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

**5. Charges:**

€ (EURO) 45,- have to be paid for each competitor at the registration before the competition.

**6. Expenses:**

The organizer does not pay for any expenses of the teams. The hotel accommodation and full board for referees, judges and members of the Technical Panels on duty, will be arranged and paid by the organizer from dinner, Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2009 until Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2009.

**7. Judges:**

Each club can enter one International Judge or Judge for I.S.U. Championships. In case of too many entries, panels of judges will be drawn on January 20<sup>th</sup> 2009. Afterwards a written confirmation will be sent to each club.

**8. Liability:**

In accordance with I.S.U. Regulations, rule 119, all participants, officials and volunteers act at their own responsibility. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors and Officials. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.

**9. Music:**

Music will be reproduced from a CD-player. CD's must be labeled with the full name of the competitor, club and category in which the competitor is entered. CD's must be handed over to the organizer immediately after the arrival of the teams.

**10. Calculation of results:**

The ISU Judging System will be used in the categories Debs, Novice, Juniors and Seniors.

Planned Program Content Sheet:

It is mandatory that the form "Planned Program Content Sheet" must be filled in for each skater of the categories Debs, Novice, Junior and Senior in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. This form must reach the organizer at latest by 20 January 2009.

## 11. Awards:

The three best-placed competitors of each event will get special presents, the others diplomas.

## 12. Organization:

The office of the organizing committee will be located at the ice rink and will be opened every day during the competition. The information desk will be open during competition time in the ice rink. ## 13. Accommodation:

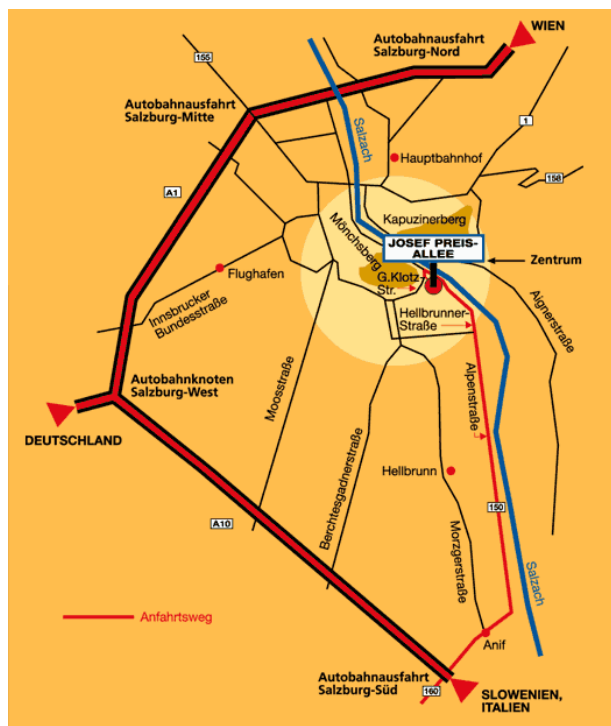
All participants, except referees and judges on duty as well as members of the Technical Panels on duty, have to pay for their own accommodation.
